OUR VISION:

ACRT is a non-profit organization that provides direct service to people living with HIV/AIDS primarily in the developing world.

Working at a community level, we tailor our programs to address real life issues facing people who have or are at high risk of contracting the disease and address the devastating consequences to the individual, family and communities in which they live. Liaising with other agencies and health care providers, we strive to provide access to essential medicines, education, services and support as well as financial assistance and/or resources as are needed.

In addition, our team members offer a variety of skills to initiate recovery, from crisis intervention and short-term care to information clinics, orphan care, and self-sustaining work and training opportunities.

STAT Program - Urgent Care

- Providing acute care and intervention in crisis situations
- Liaising with other agencies in case coordination
- Establishing short-term care facilities/ hospice
- Initiating training and support to people living with HIV/AIDS

RTI Program - Reach, Train, Invest

- Reducing the spread and impact of HIV through Education and Empowerment Programs
- Raising awareness through seminars and conferences
- Reaching remote or secluded areas and populations
- Preventing infant viral transmission with emphasis on assisting pregnant and nursing mothers through our Infant Formula Program

- Defending the rights and dignity of people with the virus, and improving the conditions that can lead to infection
- Encouraging, supporting and initiating gender equality issues
- Supporting all efforts towards self-sustainability

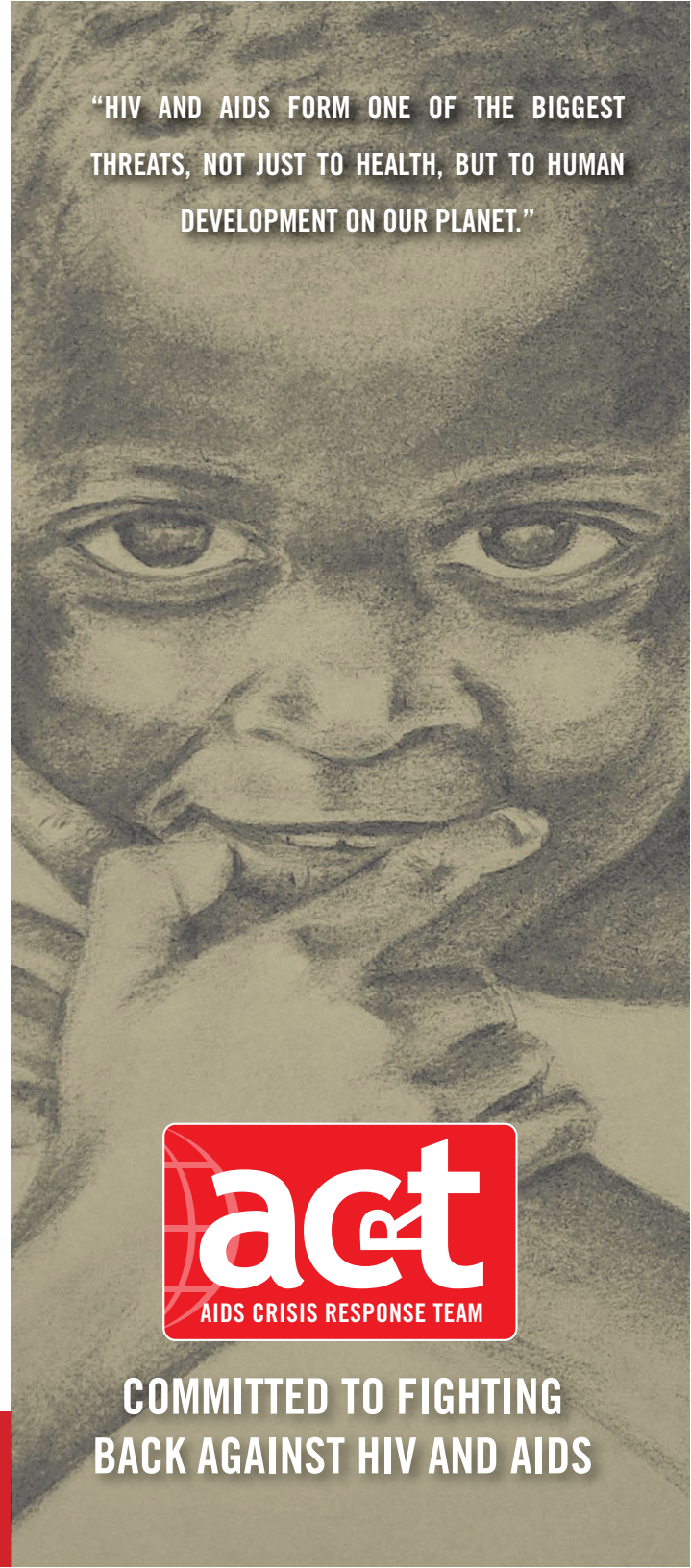
